December Ride to Malibu Bob Phinney

Chuck Beattie and I rode to the southwest corner of the San Fernando Valley taking backroads that Harvey Rawn had shown to me earlier. The plan was to eat at the Blu Jam Café which had been touted by my friend Dave who owns Cody's Café. The food was good, not great, but also pricey. However, the coffee was magnificent as was Chuck's company. The café is on Mulholland Drive just off the 101 freeway in Woodland Hills.

To get there, we took the 101 southbound to Rice Road and other surface streets to reach Potrero Road at Cal State Channel Islands (called c-suci by its students). Potrero Road leads east through some hills, canyons, castle-like estates and some suburban development.

The route is then: Potrero Road *east* becomes Lynn Road; then *south* on Reino Drive to Potrero *east* again; then take a quick ride down the dead end Hidden Valley Road to see horse estates in Happy Valley.

Motorrad in Germany but will be produced in Bangalore, India by the TVS Motor Company. It features a 313cc liquid cooled single cylinder engine which has been rotated 180 degrees and titled toward the rear compared to most other motorcycles to allow a straighter intake and exhaust path — intake in front and an exhaust exiting the rear. It produces 34 hp at 9,500 rpm and 21 ft-lbs of torque at 7,500 rpm which is enough for a bike weighing just 374 pounds. It's "designed for the world market" which means it can run on varied fuel qualities and meets local emission requirements.

No, it won't out-perform the S1000 RR, but it is probably a good choice for city commuting!

Earlier this month, I performed an 80,000 mile service on my 2002 R1150R including:

- Replaced fork seals.
- Flushed ABS system and hydraulic clutch line.
- Replaced cam chain tensioner.
- Adjusted valves.
- Replaced plugs.
- Changed engine, transmission, and final drive oils.
- Replaced oil filter.
- Cleaned air filter.
- Synced throttle bodies.
- Washed bike and self.
- Took check ride to Rock Store. Feels like a new bike!

Save the Date! BMW MOA National Rally 2017

The BMW MOA National Rally is scheduled for July 13-16, 2017, at Salt Lake City. It will be held at the Utah State Fairpark, close to the intersection of I-15 and I-80, and a light rail terminal is just outside of the fairgrounds. The light rail (TRAX) goes to many areas of Salt Lake City, including downtown and Temple Square.

For those of you that have not been to Salt Lake City in a while, it does have several brewpubs now, although the Rally will be sure to have a beer garden.

The distance from Santa Barbara to Salt Lake City is 777 miles, but that's on I-15 – boring!! An alternate route might be north up the coast, then east through Oregon and Idaho, then south into Utah. About 1700 miles – but much more scenic, and isn't getting there half the fun?

Utah has many great roads for motorcycling, including Hiway 12. July will most likely be too hot for Arches, Moab, and Zion, but the Bear River Mountain range (north of SLC) and the Uinta Mountains (east of SLC) should provide lots of entertaining roads for daytime excursions near the rally location.
