### **New F 850 GS and F 750 GS**

The F 800 GS was introduced in 2007, and now, 10 years later, BMW is producing the new 2018 F 750 GS and F 850 GS. The delineation between the two bikes remains similar. The F 750 is better for mostly asphalt and the occasional fire road. It has 77 hp at 7,500 rpm. The F 850 has 94 hp at 8,250 rpm. Both bikes have Rain and Road modes, but the F 850 has an additional three

options: Dynamic, Enduro, and Enduro Pro. ABS remains standard, and automatic stability control (ASC) is now included. BMW's eCall system will be an option (it's like a built-in Spot tracker). The fuel tank will be located between the steering head stem and the seat. The seat height for the F 850 is about 33.8 inches; for the F 750, 32 inches, but it can be lowered to about 30 inches.
