August Technical Topic: Suspension

Motorcycle suspension contributes to the bike's handling and braking; and it keeps the rider and passenger comfortably isolated from road noise, bumps and vibration. If your suspension is not right, then your tires won't work properly either.

Steve felt that the earlier bikes did not have suspension issues, but the newer bikes do have more suspension problems. Shock repair and adjustment is expensive; for example, it was noted that Electronic Suspension Adjustment (ESA) will be about \$2000 for replacement. BMW does not sell individual components, so if it fails and you are out of warranty, you need to replace the complete shock.

Suspension goes out slowly – so how do you tell when it's going? Steve suggested that riding on Highway 33 is a good test, as long as your tires are good. If the bike feels soft in the corners, then it may be time to replace or repair the shocks.

David H. suggested watching a suspension adjustment at an event such as Laguna Seca or at a rally to see what it entails.

Wayne just had his Ohlins shocks rebuilt and it cost \$665 for parts and labor, some of which was to rebuild the preload adjuster. He used Ted Porter's Beemer Shop in Scott's Valley: <u>Ted Porter's Beemer Shop</u>. Race Tech in Corona also

BMW Electric C Evolution

David H. rode his electric C evolution scooter to the club summer picnic, and then he told us about it a bit at the August club meeting. He said that it feels like it is 200 HP because it has instant torque. It has 48 HP and 53 lb-ft of torque and provides peak torque from a standstill. It accelerates 0-30 in 2.8 seconds, and it has a range of up to 99 miles. It can be charged at a charging station or a regular household power socket. The charging time is 9.2 hours on a standard 110-volt socket. David mentioned that Tesla charging stations can't be used because they are proprietary for Tesla vehicles.

The C evolution weighs 606 lbs, which is about the same as an R1200RT. It has four riding modes, storage space under the passenger seat, and a small storage compartment in the footwell.


