May Technical Topic: Patching Tires

Many members had expressed an interest in a hands-on session on patching tires, so the May meeting consisted of, first, manually puncturing two tires (it's harder than it seems it should be!); and second, repairing the punctures using a variety of techniques and materials.

Cody demonstrated with a simple set up that contained a tire reamer, plugs and a tool for insertion of the sticky plug. The tire reamer cleans out the hole and then enlarges it so plugs can be inserted. Glue is applied to the plug. This type of repair is supposed to be temporary, but no one in the Club had heard of it being a problem, although Phil mentioned that the BMW dealer in Santa Maria had seen problems with this type of repair.

Other members demonstrated different types of repair kits and the pros and cons of the various approaches were discussed. Reminder: once the glue tube is opened, the glue dries out quickly, so always carry a fresh, unopened tube of glue with you. The prevulcanized strings generally have a longer shelf life than the glue.

Phil had a Rocky Creek tire repair tool. This is made by Motopressor, and they make a repair kit and a repair tool. The kit contains the repair tool, repair strings, 3 CO₂ cartridges and an inflation tool. The repair tool has pliers, an insertion tool, a rasp and a knife.

Stop & Go Kit: This kit contains a reamer, a probe tool, a hex wrench, and mushroom plugs. However, there seem to be reports of the plugs failing, because they get cut in half by the tire cords. Stop & Go

Slime tire plug kit: One of the most economical repair kits, this one contains a reamer tool, glue, strings, and a tire plugger tool. This kit (or similar) is readily found in auto parts stores. Slime tire repair kit

Dynaplug: This set contains a Dynaplug tool (acts as a reamer), solid plugs, insertion tubes, a few other accessories, and it comes in a small case. Dynaplug

Safety Seal: These kits come with a cord spreader, self-vulcanizing plugs and grease. The cord spreader performs the function of the reamer in other kits. The grease replaces the glue and has the advantage that it never dries out. Safety Seal

In general, almost all of the repair kits or tools come in their own small pouches or cases. Many of our members have tried different types and have found their best repair kits by mixing and matching tools, strings and grease.

Arizona Passes Lane Filtering Law

As of March 22, 2022, Arizona now allows legal lane filtering. The law is similar to lane filtering laws in Utah and Montana. The law allows riders to cruise slowly between lanes at speeds no faster than 15 mph if the other vehicles are stopped. The practice can only be done on roads posted at 45 mph or less, and riders cannot pass on the shoulder or the median. Arizona Lane Filtering
